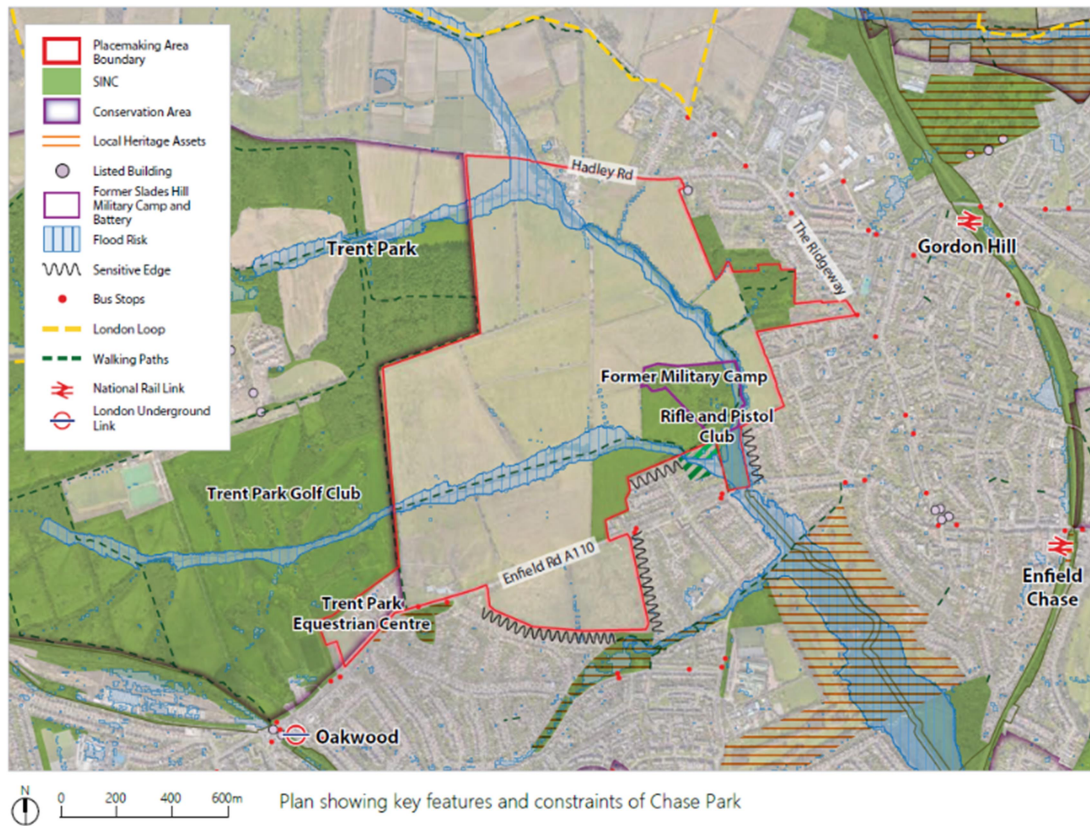

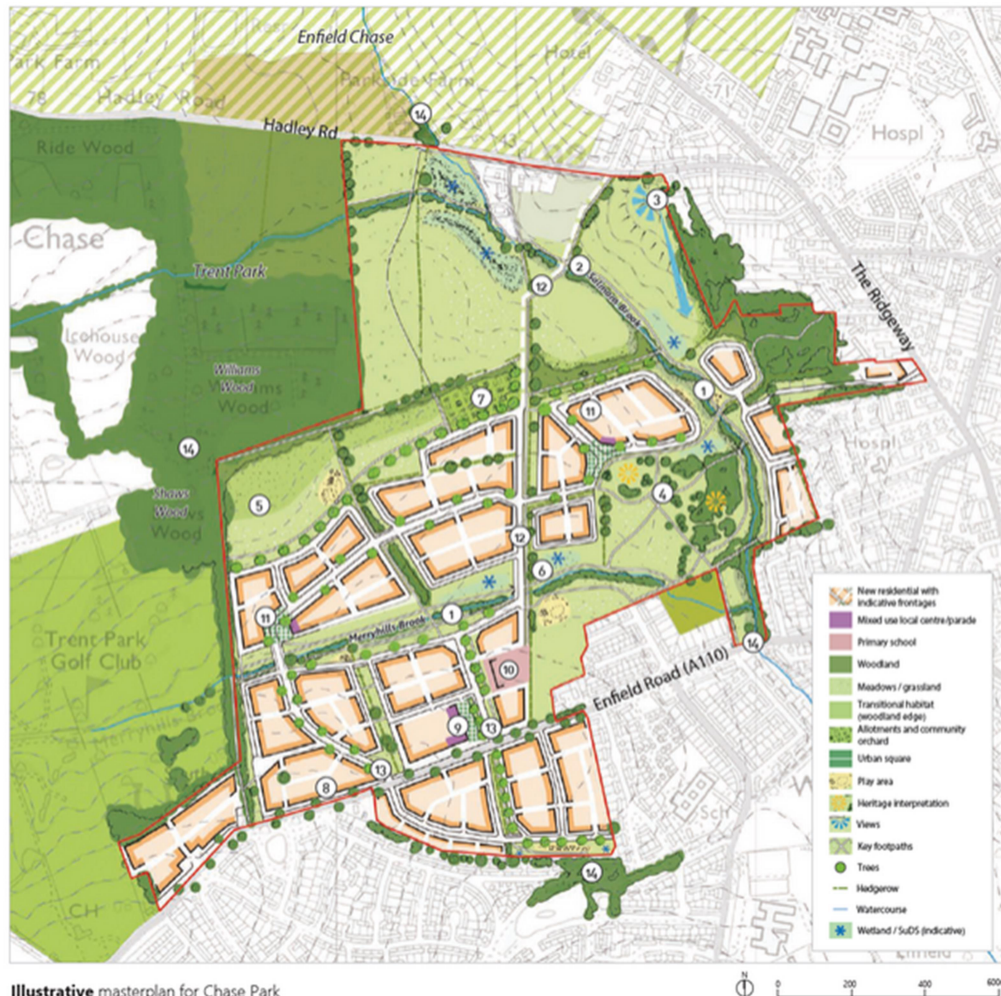

LANDSCAPE

- 1 Merryhills Brook and Salmons Brook retained
- 2 Walking routes across the Brook connecting to Enfield Chase
- 3 Potential for **viewpoint** providing long-distance views towards London skyline
- 4 A park former site of Military Camp and Battery
- 5 A park connecting to Trent Park's Williams Wood and Shaws Wood
- 6 Sustainable Drainage System (SuDS) features integrated into green spaces and residential areas, providing wetland habitats alongside flood mitigation
- 7 Allotments for community food growing

MIXED-USE NEIGHBOURHOOD

- 8 New urban character along Enfield Road
- 9 A mixed use **local centre** with a new, multi-functional urban square that can be used for **street markets**
- 10 New **primary school**
- 11 Local parades providing **small scale retail and services** will be located along a new bus route

MOVEMENT

- 12 A **sustainable movement route** for buses, walking and cycling will connect the new residential areas with Chase Farm Hospital and nearby schools
- 13 **Tree-lined boulevards** provide vehicle access from Enfield Road.
- 14 **Enhanced walking and cycling routes** will connect throughout the site and provide access to Trent Park, London Loop, and existing neighbourhoods to the east and south
