

CONCERNED ABOUT ENFIELD'S CREWS HILL & CHASE PARK NEW TOWN?

We are. Enfield Council supports a new town with up to 21,000 homes on land stretching from the M25 to Oakwood. The land at risk includes large areas of open, nature-rich and publicly accessible countryside. It also means the loss of hundreds of jobs at the garden centres at Crews Hill. **Enfield is facing decisions that will change the borough forever.** And, too often, those decisions are made without public scrutiny or distorted by misleading claims:

... they're building on car parks & garden centres.	... that they also want to build on the open countryside.

... Crews Hill golf club has "20 members", so should be built on.	... their facts are very wrong, it has 400+ members.
